CARTER HOLT HARVEY PULP AND PAPER WOOD SOURCING POLICY

It is the policy of Carter Holt Harvey Pulp and Paper Limited that all wood procured for the manufacture of pulp and paper meets the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) definition of controlled wood:

Virgin wood or wood fibre which has been verified as having a low probability of including wood from any of the following categories:

- Illegally harvested wood
- Wood harvested in violation of traditional and civil rights
- Wood harvested in forests in which high conservation values are threatened by management activities
- Wood harvested in forests being converted from natural and semi natural forest to plantations or non- forest use
- Wood from forests in which genetically modified trees are planted

All fibre is sourced from managed plantations of introduced trees in the manufacture of pulp and paper at the Kinleith, Tasman and Whakatane pulp and paper plants.
